

Examples of Supplemental Security Income Proof

To qualify for the Supplemental Security Income (SSI) reduced application fee of \$20, a Patient must submit one of the following:

- A photocopy of a SSI Determination Letter.
- A photocopy of a bank statement (containing the patient's name and SSI direct deposit).

Social Security Benefits (SSB) or Social Security Disability (SSD) do NOT qualify for a reduced fee.
